



Crime Prevention Tips

Home security:

- · Lock your doors and windows.
- Check on your storage lockers and empty your mailbox regularly.
- Wait for the gate and don't hold building doors open for strangers.

Auto security:

- Protect your garage door opener as well as your insurance and registration documents. Take them with you when parked.
- Park so it is difficult to gain access under your car. When possible park against a wall or closer to lower vehicles.
- Park in well-lit/well-populated areas where "natural surveillance" can serve as a deterrent.
- Don't leave any bags or valuables unattended in your vehicle. Not even for a moment. Not even locked in your trunk or glove box. Thieves know to check the trunk and glove box if they don't see anything out in the open.

Business security:

- Install a security system and learn how to use it.
- Train employees to recognize suspicious and criminal activity, how to respond safely and report to police.
- Don't let your windows get covered up with ads and posters. The inside of your business should be visible from the street.
- Invest in quality exterior doors and locks. Exterior doors should be solid-core and secured by at least one deadbolt with a minimum 1" throw (throw is the part that extends into the door frame when locked).
